

Pan-Armenian Students Network (draft b)

A. Objectives:

1. Developing networking **platforms** where students from different countries can interact each in their educational discipline,
2. Developing exchange **programs**,
3. Supporting students by
 - a. Directing to various local, national, international **grants, fellowships and available scholarships**,
 - b. Offering **internships** thanks to the network of worldwide Armenian managed enterprises.
 - c. Offering remote **part time jobs**.
 - d. Putting in place a start-up incubator platform as the [EPIC](#).
4. Providing students with professional **orientation**, according to needs, such as
Boosting STEM education and preparing future educators in Armenia.
Preparing political leaders and journalists to fill the gap in the Diaspora.
5. Transmitting human, moral and national **values**.

B. Implementation

It will act on three networking stratum:

- **Students,**
- **Educators,**
- **Entrepreneurs.**

In each of the networks, we need to kick off the establishment of a census **database** to list members indicating their discipline, profession, and interests; especially those who can contribute by their skills, positions or relationships. Identify the implementers. Involve particularly the “Y generation”.

- **Students**

A **project manager** should be recruited, dynamic, connected, fluent in Armenian, English and Russian, who will write a project defining the necessary resources, budget, and timeline, define the method to connect with Armenian students worldwide.

- Educators

We can cooperate with **existing educational foundations** including academics to provide with professional orientation.

Up to the 1980s' migration happened towards existing poles, Glendale, New Jersey, Laval, Alfortville...

The "new Diaspora" is scattered around different states, countries, and cities, where often there are no community structures.

We have to define the method to reach them, particularly teenagers, and often fill the vacuum of the families.

• Entrepreneurs

Generate a **network of Armenian managed enterprises** worldwide that are in search of young talents as interns or future collaborators, and will sponsor projects.

Our aim is to have a well-conceived database to enable an entrepreneur to **hunt talents** from different countries, in his/her discipline, such as biotechnology, nanotechnology, etc... but also creating cores in political science and journalism where Armenians are not well represented in the Diaspora.
